Electric Delivery Rates Decrease for Third Consecutive Year

As they rang in the New Year, Ameren Illinois residential customers began paying less for electric delivery service. Under a plan approved by the Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC), the typical Ameren Illinois residential customer will save approximately \$12 per year on the delivery portion of their electric bill — paying less than they did 10 years ago.

This represents the third consecutive rate decrease for Ameren Illinois customers and the seventh overall rate decrease since the Energy Infrastructure Modernization Act (EIMA) – or Smart Grid Bill – was passed in 2011.

Since the company began implementing its modernization action plan under the state's Smart Grid Bill, 1.2 million smart meters have been installed, power poles and wires have been strengthened, and more delivery infrastructure is being placed underground. These improvements, along with new outage detection technology, have led to a 20 percent improvement in system reliability.

Working with the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, crews were able to safely relocate the osprey nest to a platform affixed to a taller pole, providing a better bird's eye view for the fish-eating family.





LED Streetlights Pave the Way for Savings

As part of our commitment to energy efficiency and the environment, Ameren Illinois is replacing outdoor street and area lighting with high-efficiency light emitting diode (LED) technology across our service territory.

LEDs have become the driving force in the evolution of street lighting, thanks to the combination of improved nighttime visibility and safety, reduced maintenance and operational costs, and environmental benefits.

The new LED lighting uses up to 65 percent less energy and lasts three times longer than older technology. That means little maintenance is required over the first 15 years.

Ameren Illinois has installed LED lighting in 50,000 companyowned streetlights since the upgrades began. We plan to complete 350,000 by 2027.

How to Spot a Scam

Scams are on the rise, and Ameren Illinois wants to help customers protect themselves.

Many scammers pose as Ameren employees, threatening to disconnect or shut off service if a customer fails to make an immediate payment — typically using a prepaid card or other non-traceable form of payment. These criminals frequently target customers during busy or high-anxiety times such as the holiday season, COVID-19 pandemic or extreme weather.

Keys to Protecting Yourself:

- Never give your credit card, debit card, social security, ATM, checking
 or savings account numbers to anyone who calls, sends a text message
 or email, or comes to your home requesting this information.
- Don't trust anyone asking for immediate payment. If you suspect someone is impersonating an Ameren employee, end the conversation and immediately call Ameren Illinois at 1.800.755.5000.
- Never purchase a prepaid card to avoid service disconnection or shutoff. Legitimate energy companies do not specify how customers should make a bill payment and always offer a variety of ways to pay a bill. Ameren customers can make payments online, by phone, electronic check, by mail or at in-person pay locations.
