Operating nine Express Mart stores south of the St. Louis Metro area, Home Service Oil Co. has been providing drinks, snacks, fuel and other convenience store staples to customers since their founding in 1930. Since convenience stores use 3–7 times fmore energy than other businesses, Home Service Oil knows the value of keeping costs down while providing a comfortable experience for their customers. That's why the company has worked with Ameren Missouri's BizSavers program to save money and energy, earning more than \$46,000 in Ameren incentives and reducing their annual energy costs by more than \$68,000.

Project Summary

Focusing their energy efficiency projects primarily on lighting upgrades, Home Service Oil has replaced more than 800 incandescent, fluorescent and HID lamps lights with LEDs both inside and outside their convenience stores. The company has utilized a mix of Standard and Custom lighting incentives and has participated in the Small Business Direct Install program, which offers increased incentive rates for small business customers. These upgrades have reduced Home Service Oil's energy use by more than 796,000 kWh every year.

than \$46,000 in incentives as a result of their
commitment to energy efficiency. Because of the
generous incentives and annual energy cost savings,
and since lighting projects generate such a quick ROI,
